3 Ahead!

The Portuguese team "Maria João Lara" leads by 3 VPs, after having 5 wins (16-14, 20-10, 25-0, 20-10 and 16-14) and 1 defeat in match 6(11-19).

The Dutch "Beyer" team is just behind. They won 3 matches (25-0, 20-10 and 17-13) and lost another 3 (14-16, 14-16 and 12-18), but managed to keep up with the leading teams.

The Austrian/German team "Van Helsing" is third. They are just 8 VPs behind the leaders. They won 3 matches (25-5, 25-4 and 19-11), lost 2 (6-24 and 10-20) and were even in the 6th round.

The team in fourth place, the Icelanders "Sparisjodur Keflavikur" is 10 VPs behind the "Van Helsing" team. They won 25-2, 25-5, 25-5 and 23-7, lost round 6 by 0-25 and had 15-15 in round 7.

Much happened here in the bridge room yesterday. At dinner time, the Welsh/Latvian team "Yelena" was leading by 5 VPs, after winning all three matches in the afternoon (23-7, 24-6 and 19-11). They lost their lead in the evening by losing all three matches.

Today anything can happen. Any swing can give or take a place in the ranking.

Trump Reduction

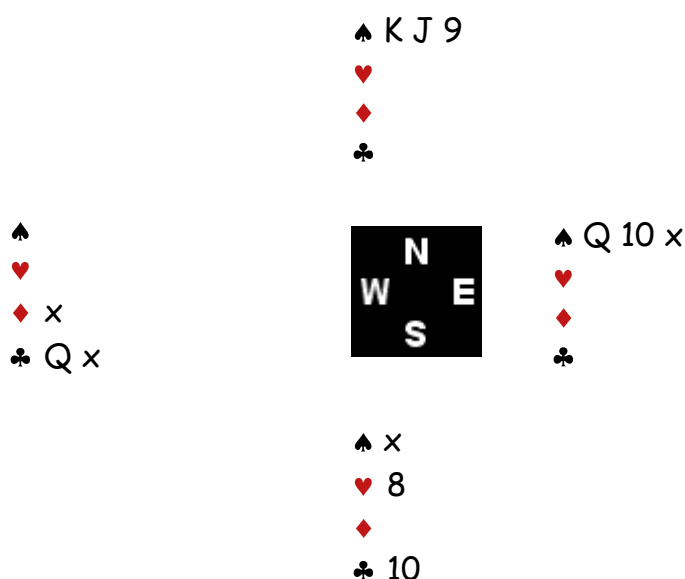
Miguel Teixeira is the head of this tournament's organizing committee. If you read previous year's bulletins you will know he is also famous for his slams, either bidding or winning difficult ones. This year is no exception. Here is a board played on table 5.

After a 12-14 1NT opening by South, Miguel sitting North started with a forcing 3♠ instead of a transfer bid, thus protecting his Kings (and his declaring). They quickly ended up in 6♠. Carlos Pimenta, on the East seat led the normal ♥Q. Miguel won with dummy's Ace and made the first key play of the hand by immediately ruffing a heart in hand. This is the kind of precaution that seldom costs and is sometimes highly rewarded. When he cashed the ♠A and saw the bad news he went into a huddle. He now made the second key play. He played the ♦K and a diamond to the Ten! He discarded a club on the ♦A and ruffed another heart. ♣K and Ace were followed by another heart ruff leaving this end-position:

Now it was a simple matter of playing the ♠9 from hand and wait to take the final two tricks. A nice trump coup to make this slam. Maybe that's the reason he keeps organizing this event - so he can do this kind of mischief to his friends.

Why did he finesse in diamonds instead of clubs? Well you may say that since you are playing for E to hold 4-4 in the majors and 3-2 in the minors it is slightly more likely that he holds 3 diamonds and 2 clubs since you can see 6 clubs between the two hands and only 5 diamonds, but I think it's a pure guess. And when was the last time Miguel took a wrong view when playing a slam? I don't know... But keep coming back. When he does we'll put it on the bulletin!

Gonca opened with a Polish Club. His partner's response showed 6 cards and was not forcing (6-7 pts is what is recorded on the Vugraph). The Austrians now got safely to 3♦. Maybe South's hand was worth one more bid but there is no clear cut way to get to 5♦. Things got a little out of hand in the closed room. We don't have access to the auction but the Welsh somehow got doubled in 3♦ and when the smoke cleared they had managed 11 tricks for +1070 and 14 imps.

What a start! 31 imps on the first 2 boards! The Van Helsing team recovered a few imps on the remaining boards but after this start they naturally ended up losing by 35-17.
