### The Final Push



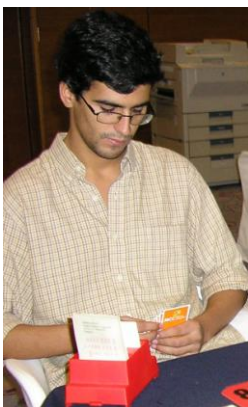
The "Maria João Lara" team is the winner of this year's Teams Tournament.

That may have cost them their side bet with their team-mates, but I am sure we all agree in saying that such a nice attitude from nice young players should always be public. So, this time all the anonymous fair players present in Madeira are represented by Magnus Magnusson and Johann Sigurdarson.
