Twilight Zone Bridge

Mr. J. and Mr. J. are two well known and well liked gentlemen from our Island. They are regular bridge players here, most of the times playing with each other.

On the very first session of the pairs tournament Mr. J., Vul vs. Not Vul. picked up:

♠ Q 10 7 5 4 3
♥ Q 10 7 5 4 2
♦
♣ K

Both his left hand opponent and his partner passed and right hand opponent opened 1♣. Since they weren't playing two-suited overcalls and feeling he hadn't quite enough for a 1 level overcall Mr. J. elected to pass. LHO bid 1♦, pass from partner and 1NT from RHO. Now, with both opponents limited it didn't feel quite right to Mr. J. to pass again. With so little to choose between his two suits he tried entering the auction as cheaply as he could and so bid 2♥. LHO bid 3♦, partner passed and RHO bid 3NT that went pass-pass-Double from the other Mr. J..

Fearing, and rightly so, that North should have a good Heart stopper, Mr. J. led the 4th best from his longest and strongest suit - in this case the ♠5.

This was the whole deal:

When Mr J. and Mr. J proceeded to cash the first six tricks in Spades declarer started shouting "Director! Director! - The opponents failed to alert a transfer bid!"

A few boards later the other Mr. J, sitting West, had:

♠ 6
♥ 10 7 4 3
♦ K 8
♣ K Q J 10 8 7

After a pass from partner, RHO opened with 1♠ and Mr. J. went in with 2♣, the opponents ending up in 4♠. This was the full deal:

The lead was the ♣K. Nothing unusual about that, or the bidding. The card play, on the other hand...

It started quite normally. South took the Ace and played the ♦Q, covered by King and Ace. Next came the ♠Q, again covered by King and Ace. A Spade now went to the Jack, declarer noticing West's Club discard. South now played Ace and King of

Hearts and ruffed a Heart in hand. A Club ruff followed, ending dummy's trumps. So far so good. It was when declarer played a Diamond to the Jack that things started to go a little sour. West took the trick with the King(!). He now cashed the ♣King and gave partner a Club ruff. The ruff would have been unnecessary since the ♣7 was the highest around, but everything seemed a bit confusing to the other Mr. J.. There was even a Diamond ruffed with the ♠6, but no one noticed and the Diamond trick was made. When the smoked cleared South had managed to end up with 10 tricks but that was worth a complete zero. Everyone felt quite puzzled, but no one seemed to really grasp what had happened. The Director shouted "Change!" and everybody did. It was only when Mr. J. and Mr. J. had already left the table that light came to the declarer - "He played the ♦K twice!". "Director!". The Director ruled that not only the ♦K had been played twice, but also the ♣K and all other cards played by West after it. Apparently Mr. J. had set down his cards at some point and picked the ones already played!

This is a true story. As usual, the names have been changed to protect the innocent.
