Do something intelligent

Two boards from the Open Pairs, Session I.

Quiz

1. As East you have:

♠ Q 4 ♥ 4 3 2 ♦ J 7 3 ♣ 10 7 6 5 2

Love all, partner opens a strong NoTrump (15-17), RHO passes and you do the same. Lefty balances with a double, explained as 'some points, but not necessarily penalty', and they end up in 2♠. You feel you have to lead through dummy so you kick off with the ♥2 (third and fifth) and dummy comes down:

dummy

♠ 9 8 2

♥ A J 8 6

♦ K 9 4

♣ K 4 3

you

♠ Q 4

♥ 4 3 2

♦ J 7 3

♣ 10 7 6 5 2

Dummy plays low, and declarer wins partner's ten with the Queen. Next comes the ♣J to partner's Ace. When you win the spade shift with your Queen - declarer the three - you are expected to do something intelligent, but what?

2. This time you are sitting South with:

♠ - ♥ 2 ♦ A J 10 9 7 6 5 ♣ A 10 9 7 4

Again love all. Being the dealer you consider to open 5♦, but looking at your two aces you decide to begin with a 'normal' 1♦. The bidding proceeds:

* invitational for a heart game

Your bid please:

- a. 5♣
- b. 5♦
- c. Pass
- d. dbl (meant as Lightner, partner lead something intelligent, hopefully a spade)

Solutions

Against 2♠ by North East led a heart for ten and Queen. West won the ♣J and returned a low spade to the Queen. At the table East switched to a diamond. This way defence was able to obtain two diamonds, a club and two spades. Declarer's heart loser eventually was pitched on dummy's third club.

So, it seems that an unnatural heart return would have killed the contract. Still declarer will survive because he will be always in the position to get rid of two diamond losers - one on the fourth heart and one on the third club.

So the only defence was two win the ♥K in the first trick.

The way to beat 4♥ is when NS find a timely spade ruff (probably found after the Lightner double). So don't feel bad when you end up playing 5♦. The contract is likely to go down one only.

On yesterday's board 2 most pairs ended up in 4♠. When the diamonds split 3-3, 12 tricks were there for the taking. 14 pairs managed to get to the slam (3 going down) and there was even one pair that reached the Grand!

An Easy Board

Sometimes bridge is much easier than you think it is. Take for instance this heart game deriving from Session 2, Madeira Open Pairs (rotated for convenience):

♠ K 8 6 3
♥ K Q 7 6
♦ A K 7
♣ K 4



♠ Q 5 4
♥ A 10 9 8 5 2
♦ 8 5 4
♣ Q

West	North	East	South
	1♦	pass	1♥
pass	4♥	All pass	

When West kicks off with ♣A and another club, it is tempting to pitch a diamond on the ♣K. In fact the bulk of the field followed that line. Therefore 4♥ making ten tricks was slightly under average.

But how to make eleven tricks? Pitch a spade instead of that diamond and later develop the suit. As it happens with spades 3-3 declarer ends up with an overtrick and scores eighty percent on the board. Bridge is easy, isn't it? By the way, even on a diamond lead this line would pay off.

This was the whole hand:
