## And we started!

Yesterday, 140 pairs from at least 18 different countries met for the first session of the Pairs' Tournament.



After that beautiful sunny morning, everybody was looking forward to the first pairs' session.

The Austrians Sylvie and Franz Terraneo were the

winners yesterday. They made 65.85% and got the lead of the tournament.

The Portuguese Manuel Oliveira and Rui Silva Santos, who have been coming to this tournament since it started 16 years ago, got second place, with 64.55%.

The German pair Helmut Häusler and Michael Gromöller are third, just 0.97% behind the Portuguese.

There are 26 pairs within 10% of the lead. What will happen today?



## Unlucky expert play

Former Dutch champion and international Hans Vergoed and Yaël Topiol, current member of the Belgian ladies team, had an extremely unlucky first session. This hand was illustrative for the way they operated:

Vergoed as West had become declarer in 4♥ after North had overcalled 2♦. Vergoed ruffed the third diamond and cashed Ace-King of hearts. Having seen ♦A with South, he was sure North to have ♣K for his vulnerable overcall. Nonetheless, he first tried to ruff down ♠Q: ♠A, spade to the King and a spade ruffed. Next he played a heart to the Queen, a club to the Ace and a small club. To his astonishment South produced ♣K-J and the contract was one off.

Without any interference there are several ways to play the contract. The line Vergoed chose (if there is no clue on the position of ♣K) has a 71.2% chance. The alternative is to draw trumps, ending in hand, and play a club to the 10 (or the Q). If this loses to ♣J, you win the return and play ♠A and a spade to the Jack. This gives you an overall chance of 75.5%, but you will be two off if the spade finesse loses.

Another winning line is to draw trumps, ruff the third spade and play a club to 10 or Q. South wins but is endplayed. If you can deduct from the first three tricks that South is stripped of his diamonds, the most elegant way to play the contract presents itself: draw trumps, cash ♠A and then duck a club to South who is endplayed. If he returns a club you have the option to let it run or go up with ♣A and finesse in spades, both lines leading to ten tricks.

The contract of 4♥ was reached at 42 tables. It was made 26 times (once plus one and once doubled) and went down 16 times (twice down two). Plus 620 was

97-31 for EW, whereas minus 100 was 107-21 for NS. Seventeen EW-pairs stayed in 2 or 3♥. Plus 170 was slightly above average for EW (65), whereas plus 140 was a good score for NS (80).
