Trading chances

West leads \$2 (third and fifth) and dummy comes down:

- A 98
- 96
- K432
- AQ54
- Q 5 4 A K Q J 4
- J 5
- 10 8 2


East wins the King and returns & J. Plan the play.



With eight tricks in the bank your prospects look pretty good. You finesse K first and if that doesn't work you play lefty for the A. But what if both cards are off side? Is there a way to increase your chances?

Yes there is. Win the spade return in dummy, cash three or four rounds of hearts - pitch one or two diamonds from dummy - play a club to the queen and East is endplayed:

Board 11 - 1st Session Teams Dealer S None vul.



The best East can do is return a low club. If declarer inserts the ten, he is home. If declarer however misguesses, he takes the nine with the ace and returns a club. With clubs 3-3 the contract is still made as East is endplayed again.

So you traded the fifty percent chance of a favourable diamond position to a fifty percent second round guess in clubs. However you increased your chance with thirty percent when clubs break.





The 4-1 break put an end to that, the bulk of the field being in 7.



On the teams' event...

- (1) Support double showing 3 cards in A
- (2) Cue-bid
- (3) Roman Key-card Blackwood
- (4) 2 Key cards, no ♠Q

A revealing sequence. West knew East had to have more than two aces for his bidding. After the Q lead West decided to ruff 2 clubs in dummy. The spades have to be 2-2, but that's not enough - there's the small matter of communications. East has to come to his hand with a heart or diamond ruff. The diamond lead looked a bit fishy... If you come in with a heart ruff you need hearts to be at least 4-2. With a diamond you need them to be at least 5-3. [A priory figures for that give you 10,495% for a void, singleton or doubleton diamond with South and 8,011 for a void or singleton heart with South. The problem is that you need to come twice to hand - one for the ruff and another to take out trumps- so you will need both diamonds 5-3 and hearts 4-2 (best) or diamonds 4-4 or hearts 3-3, assuming always that South will have the shorter stack - Ed.1

West chose to ruff a heart... No more 7♠ for us.
