The final card has been played in a tournament of records – Warm Up Pairs, Open Pairs, Open Teams and even a record number of tables broadcast on BBO.

In the Open Teams after three gruelling days of competition the Nuno Matos Team of Miguel Teixeira, Diego Brenner, Carlos Luiz and Nuno Paz emerged victorious ahead of team Gladpack: Espen Fasting, Kaare Bogow, Steffen Simonsen and Marius Bartnes, whilst Hans & Monique Melchers, Bob Drijver, Bart Nab, Louk Verhees and Ricco van Prooijen of Onstein were third.

The Nuno Matos Team won this tournament 20 years ago and without doubt will be here next November 5th for the start of the twenty-first Madeira Bridge Festival.

Icelandic players have been coming to the Bridge Festival in Madeira for 15 years. Everyone has always been so happy with the schedule and organisation that when they have gone home it has been easy to get more people to come. This year we have 50 players and more than 20 people accompanying them, and that tells you more than a few words can say about how happy everyone is with the Bridge Festival in Madeira.

Recorded Highlights

Mark Horton reports on Rounds 7 & 8 of the Teams Championships



By now you will have worked out the subtlety of yesterday's headline - Day Night Matches - they are popular in cricket, which I featured in the introduction to the report on some deals from the afternoon session.

Test Matches are generally played between the hours of 11.00 and 19.00 each day and it is not always possible to follow the play (publishers tend to get aggrieved if manuscripts are not delivered on time) but there will always be a highlights programme later in the day showing the best of the action.

So it is with bridge on BBO - you can't really follow everything at once, but you can record matches and check them later for highlights. That's how this report on Rounds 7 & 8 was compiled.

West led the ace of hearts and declarer ruffed in dummy and ran the nine of spades. When West took this trick, declarer's problems were over. The club return was taken in hand, a heart ruffed with the ♠K, hand entered with a club and trumps draw followed by a claim, +980.

However, if West ducks the nine of spades, declarer cannot possibly come to more than 11 tricks.

The bidding and play in the other room were identical - no swing and a missed opportunity for both sides.

5♣ will make easily if West leads a heart - declarer wins, cashes dummy's top clubs and plays a second heart, quickly disposing over dummy's diamond, but West led the ace of diamonds and continued with the seven. Declarer ruffed in dummy, cashed the ace of clubs, played a spade to the ace and advanced the nine of clubs. When West followed with the five declarer went up with the king - and down went the contract, another 12 IMPs for Team Nuno Matos.

One way to approach North's type of hand is to overcall 1♦. You may get a chance to double some number of clubs on the next round to show your extra values.

West led the ace of spades and switched to the nine of clubs, declarer taking East's queen with the king and playing a diamond to the nine. East won with the jack, cashed the queen of spades and played a club, West taking his tricks for two down, -300 and 9 IMPs.
