CONGRESS CENTRE

Opposite the entrance to VidaMar.

The pre-tournament events and Warm-Up Pairs are played here, as well as several sections of the main events.

VUGRAPH (TEAMS ONLY)

In the Congress Centre – through the double doors on the right-hand side of the lobby, just past the bar.

SELVAGENS SUITE

In VidaMar Tower 2.

The Warm-Up Pairs, main events and Cool-Down Pairs will be played here.

This is also where Mark Horton gives his 'Replay these hands with me' sessions from Tuesday to Friday.

DESERTAS SUITE

In VidaMar Tower 1 (turn right at Reception).

One section of the Open Teams will be played here.

OCEAN ROOM

In VidaMar Tower 1, on Level 0, near the pools. Access is from either tower: Tower 1 has two lifts and Tower 2 has one.

This is where part of the Open Pairs tournament will be played.

Please start making your way to this playing area early, because the lifts will be busy.

TEAMS REGISTRATION

If your name does not appear on this list, you will need to do one of the following:

- a) If you know who your team-mates are you need to register the team by 18:30 on Friday 7th November (otherwise we do not know who is playing in which team). You can:
 - register at the Welcome Desk, or
 - fill in the green form at the Welcome Desk and put it in the box, or
 - register online at https://booking.bridge-madeira.com/registrations
 (you will need the Bridgemate numbers of everyone in the team).
- b) If you find team-mates yourselves before the end of the Open Pairs tournament please tell the Welcome Desk, who will **register** the team for you; or you can **register** online (as above); or fill in the green form with the names and Bridgemate numbers of everyone in the team.
- c) If you have already told us that you would like us to find team-mates for you, you do not need to do anything: we will match you with the pair closest in standard.
- d) If you do not have team-mates and would like us to find them for you, please complete the green form at the Welcome Desk and put it in the box provided.

We will notify pairs of the teams we have arranged for them at lunchtime on Friday 7th November.

Anyone who has paid the entry fee for the Open Teams is entitled to play in the event provided they have filled in the green form by 18:30 on Friday 7th November.

If, however, you have not notified us by 20:30 on Thursday 6th November that you need teammates, we will make up teams from the pairs who are in the same position at 18:30 on Friday and you may find yourselves in a team with players of a very different standard.

After 18:30 we may not be able to accommodate you in the tournament at all.

We cannot accept any new entries from players who have not already booked a place in the tournament.

Thursday 6th November 20:30

Deadline for requests for team-mates (we will match you with the pair of the closest level). After this time we will allocate pairs to teams in the order in which we receive the request, without any attempt to match players by level.

Friday 7th November 18:30

Final deadline for Teams registration. After this time we cannot guarantee that you will be able to play.



This year's charity is the Special Education Unit at the Dr. Horácio Bento de Gouveia School in Funchal.

The Unit was set up to ensure that all children, without exception, are included in education and their individual needs addressed. It aims to be a universal school where every child and young person receives the care, attention and respect they deserve from others, and has the opportunity to realise their learning potential.

Difference is not a problem, but a value which enriches and challenges the creativity of education professionals.

This is only possible with the involvement of everyone: not only the school but the entire community. Everyone in the community can contribute to a more open, inclusive, and humane society.

In this spirit the Special Education Unit was launched in 2013. It has developed and adapted over the years to meet the needs of its students and to conform to changes in the legal framework.

It provides:

- Part of a continuum of educational responses for students with evident and persistent difficulties in communication, interaction, cognition, or learning.
- A dynamic, supportive structure which uses human and material resources to support inclusion and promote a flexible curriculum.
- Promotes a sense of belonging and participation in classes, routines, and school activities.
- Promotes access to leisure, social participation and independent living.
- Uses an interdisciplinary approach to learning, autonomy and adaptation to the school context.
- Supports the transition to post-school life, making best use of the school's existing resources and establishing partnerships for community participation.
- Promotes regular family involvement and engagement with other services.

Your Directors

JOSÉ JÚLIO CURADO

Joint Chief TD

In October 1996 José Júlio decided that he wanted to know the Laws of Bridge. Two years later he was invited to direct the first edition of this tournament, with Rui

He has represented the Contract Bridge Association of Ireland in the Camrose Home Internationals, and has been NPC to various Irish teams (his most recent being the Irish Mixed Team in Madeira in June 2022). His other interests are golf and rugby.

SARAH AMOS

Sarah began her TD career in Wales, where she is Chief Tournament Director and still runs many



events. She joined the EBU TD panel over 20 years ago and runs all types of bridge events all over the UK, from club games to home internationals. The 28th Madeira Festival


Those mathematically minded will know that 28 is a perfect number and in particular it is the second such. I sincerely hope that I will be here for the occasion of the third perfect number (I suspect it is unlikely, see why at end of article*). Obviously the Madeira International Bridge Open is correctly associated with the word 'perfect'. Yet again we have smashed records for participants. We have had to close entries for the main Pairs event with 372 pairs registered. There are already 158 teams entered and with more than 50 persons not yet formed into teams that number will climb significantly.

Every year I bang on that all of us behind the scenes are now part of a 'family' but for me there is more than one family, firstly the hotel staff, where we have a mutual joy at meeting one another again. There is even a small family in the little café opposite the hotel where most mornings I go for my bica and pastéis de nata at around 11 o'clock. It is still mainly the same staff I met 12 years ago.

This year I am stepping back a little and the role of actually laying out the bulletin falls to a new member of our family, Monika Kümmel (she is such a good layout person that I am sure she will have the correct accent on her name). We do have two important things in common, the first being that we are foreigners living in a foreign land, the land in question being France. Monika is Austrian and is fluent in French, English and German and maybe more, so it is difficult to say anything about her she will not understand. The second commonality, and maybe the more important, is we have a shared pleasure in eating large pieces of dead cow accompanied by potatoes whipped up with garlic and Auvergnat cheese washed down with copious quantities of red Saint-Pourcain wine, a very good wine for bridge players as it is a jeu de mot for 100%.

Normally at this point in my disquisition I mention a hand I played since the last festival and who am I to interfere with a tradition that I created, so....

Last year after the festival I stayed on for a week for a little holiday. I was fortunate enough to be invited to play in the Madeira Bridge Association Christmas duplicate and partnered Ceri, my righthand in the bulletin room. After three or four rounds we were doing well and perchance came upon Laura and Pedro as our opponents. The following hand I played in 3NT and I thought that the deal was quite interesting.



East (Laura) dealt and opened 3♠ over which I immediately bid 3NT. Ceri did well to pass, it could well have been right to press on but she correctly deduced that I was probably under some pressure to find a bid. The lead was a 3rd and 5th ◆4 which went to the ◆9 and king. I then cashed the top two club honours discarding a diamond. My table presence told me that the club suit was not giving me five tricks but if that was the case then it was probable that the heart suit was breaking kindly and if East held the jack then there would three tricks available in the suit. However, when a small heart to dummy's king lost to the ace and then on the heart return the ♥10 lost to the jack,



things did not seem to be going to plan. West now exited with his spade, won in hand, and the ♥Q cashed and finding the expected good news of the heart split. Now there was light at the end of the tunnel. I crossed to dummy with the king of spades, cashed the thirteenth heart, West having discarded a club and a diamond. I now played the ◆8 forcing West to win with the ◆10 and when he cashed the ♣Q I discarded the ◆J from dummy and West kindly exited the ◆Q allowing me to win the final trick with the ◆7.

The observant among you will realise that there are always ten tricks to be had. If you are confident that East started with seven spades then ace and a small club at tricks two and three will see you home. Basically West is thrown in – he can exit the first time with a spade, which you win in hand and then play king and another club this time the throw in is costly and you will come to ten tricks if

you read the cards correctly. However nine tricks was enough for a good result on the board (and a beer).

Not only did I get a beer but Ceri and I were fortunate enough to finish first and the cerise sur le gateau was that at the end of the tournament we all enjoyed a great dinner all together to complete a most pleasant day.

* If there is an event in Madeira every year, then with the next perfect number being 496 it will be 2507 when the event takes place. I suspect that by then humankind will have allowed itself to be destroyed – so let's have some fun while we are still here.
